

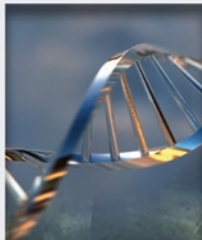

The Georgia Life Sciences Summit, Growing Georgia's Bioeconomy, will be held Wednesday, October 3, 2007 at the Georgia World Congress Center in Atlanta. The Summit is considered the preeminent gathering of scientists and industry decision makers for Georgia's life sciences community, and an ideal medium to foster relationships for future scientific and business growth and opportunity.

This year, reflecting Georgia's growing bioeconomy, Georgia Bio (GaBio) is excited to be expanding our conference to reflect agriculture, food nutrition, bioenergy, and industrial production in addition to our traditional focus on biomedicines. Abstracts will be subject to the same scientific review as for any national or regional meeting. The scientific content of poster presentations should reflect the following categories:

- Cell Therapy & Tissue Engineering
- Drug Discovery and Development
- Food Nutrition
- Industrial Production
- Medical Technology and Devices
- Molecular and Biological Research

For student, post-doctoral or non-profit organization abstracts selected, the corresponding author of each poster will receive complimentary registration to the Summit. In addition, posters submitted by students will be eligible for a limited number of poster awards.
